Eligibility:

Open to all Orange County artists 18 years of age or older. Work must be original and executed within the past two years. Work must not have been previously exhibited at City Hall. Entry in this exhibit establishes an agreement on the part of the artist to all conditions listed in the prospectus.

Media: Two dimensional art works measuring no more than 36" x 36" framed.

Entry Fee: A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 for up to three entries.

Juror: Jonathan Burke is the President of the Laguna College of Art + Design in Laguna Beach. From 1985 to 2011 Jonathan was the Dean of Fine Arts and the Gallery Director. In addition he taught freshman through graduate levels in fine arts and continued an exhibition career. Jonathan's background is representational drawing and painting with still life and landscape as his main emphasis. He holds a B.F.A. degree in painting from Kansas City Art Institute and M.F.A degree in painting from Boston University.

Entry Procedures: Submit up to three (3) pieces by registering and uploading images at www.lagunabeachcity.slideroom.com. Payment is made on the secure server with any major credit card.

Condition of Entries: All work must be completely dry, framed, wired and ready for hanging, or otherwise suitably prepared for exhibition. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted.
