Draft Historic Preservation Ordinance - The City of Laguna Beach will hold a public workshop with the Heritage Committee on Thursday, June 16, 2016, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers (505 Forest Avenue). The workshop will be held to discuss and receive public comment on a revised draft of the Historic Preservation Ordinance (Municipal Code Section 25.45). The City Attorney will also be present to discuss the ordinance as it relates to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). It's Time to Renew Your Shopper Parking Permits! - Residents who have participated in the shopper parking permit program in the past should have already received their 2016-2018 application in the mail. If you did not receive an application, or are interested in the program, please visit the City's website at www.lagunabeachcity.net. Just click the "Shopper Permits" icon located on the City's home page. From the website, residents can purchase parking permits [on-line](#) or by mail by downloading a PDF version of the information packet and application. The cost is \$80 each for the first two shopper permits and \$150 each for the third and fourth permit. If you received an application in the mail, please note that the enclosed Shopper Parking Reference Sheet referenced valid dates of August 1, 2014 – July 31, 2016. This date was incorrect. New Shoppers Permits are valid from August 1, 2016 through July 31, 2018. A revised Shopper Parking Permit Reference Sheet will be included with your shopper permit receipt.
