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**Fall Quarter 2016 Registration Activities** - Registration for Fall 2016 recreation activities is now available. **Anita/Seaview Street Storm Drain Improvements** - Work continues to progress for storm drain construction along Anita Street, Avalon Avenue, and Seaview Street, between Catalina Street and Temple Terrace. Portions of streets will be closed and restricted to local access only during the working hours of 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Detours will be provided and minor traffic impacts can be anticipated. After Labor Day, the project will continue along Anita Street between Catalina Street and Gaviota Drive. **Emergency Access Improvement Program Community Presentation** - The City will hold a community presentation on a proposed Emergency Access Improvement Program designed for the streets off of Alta Vista Way, commonly called the alphabet streets. The presentation will be held on Saturday, August 13, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. at the Susi Q Community Center at 380 Third Street. The focus of the presentation will identify the need for improved access for emergency vehicles and will identified areas where new parking restrictions could be imposed. The public is invited to attend.

**Draft Historic Preservation Ordinance** - The City of Laguna Beach will hold a public workshop with the Heritage Committee on Thursday, August 25, 2016, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers (505 Forest Avenue). The workshop will be held to discuss and receive public comment on the most recent revisions of the Historic Preservation Ordinance (Municipal Code Section 25.45).
