**Street Resurfacing** - Street resurfacing is scheduled to begin on October 19 and will continue till December in the following areas: upper Bluebird Canyon, Alta Vista Way and lettered streets, Nyes Place, Victoria Beach, and the general area bordered by Cress Street, Alta Vista Way, the Diamond/Crestview neighborhood and the Coast. Preliminary work will require temporary street closures on Dyer Place, Smith Way, and a small portion of Bluebird Canyon Drive near Eastman Way on October 14 between 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Affected residents and businesses have been notified of the project. ## 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Flood Prevention Device

## PRACTICE INSTALLATION DAY

### October 24, 2016

#### Attention Business Owners and Employees:

Per section 25.38.055 (B)(1) of the Laguna Beach Municipal Code, the last Monday of each October has been designated as Flood Prevention Device Practice Installation Day. This is a voluntary educational emergency preparedness training event encouraged by FEMA. Business owners and employees are requested to practice the installation of the flood prevention devices. Therefore on Monday, October 24, 2016, we ask that you schedule a time to review your Floodproofing Measures Plan with all staff. This should include notification of where the flood prevention devices are stored and installation directions. All employees should be provided a copy of the Floodproofing Measures Plan and have the opportunity to install a flood prevention device at a designated opening.

In the event of a disaster, all property and business owners who have registered through the AlertOC system will receive an emergency alert notification. To register, go to [www.alertoc.org](http://www.alertoc.org).
