SUBJECT: WEEKLY UPDATES

Health Expo & Free Flu Shot Clinic - The annual Health Expo and Free Flu Shot Clinic will take place on Friday, November 4, 8:30 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. at the Laguna Beach Community & Susi Q Center, 380 Third Street, Laguna Beach. Flu shots are available on a first-come, first-service basis while supplies last for those 18 years and older. The Health Expo will feature a number of community services, resources providing awareness and educational information, as well as free blood pressure and hearing screenings. Arch Beach Heights Access - The two projects listed below near the Arch Beach Heights neighborhood will be under construction. All lane and street closures necessary to implement both projects have been reviewed and coordinated to minimize inconvenience and provide access at all times. There won't be lane closures on all the streets on the same day. Emergency access is being provided at all times on all streets.

1. **Summit Drive Utility Undergrounding** - On October 24, 2016, construction to accommodate the undergrounding of overhead utilities along the 700 Block of Summit Drive will begin. The road will be reduced to one lane for both directions between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction is scheduled to be complete in December 2016 with overhead wires and poles being removed by December 2017.
2. **Street Resurfacing** - Street resurfacing will continue until December in the following areas: upper Bluebird Canyon, Alta Vista Way and lettered streets, Nyes Place, Victoria Beach, and the general area bordered by Cress Street, Alta Vista Way, the Diamond/Crestview neighborhood and the Coast. Affected residents and businesses have been notified of the project. Updated closure dates and other project information are available on the City's website: www.lagunabeachcity.net/slurryseal.

Anita/Seaview Street Storm Drain Improvements - Anita Street at South Coast Highway will continue to be closed 24 hours a day for approximately two more weeks. In early November, one lane of Glenneyre Street will be closed in each direction at Anita Street from 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. This will allow for construction of the storm drain across Glenneyre Street. The lane closures are expected to last for two weeks, and the overall project is scheduled to be completed by the end of November. For questions, please contact Tom Sandefur at (949) 497-0792.

4th Annual Flood Prevention Device PRACTICE INSTALLATION DAY

October 24, 2016

Attention Business Owners and Employees:

Per section 25.38.055 (B)(1) of the Laguna Beach Municipal Code, the last Monday of each October has been designated as Flood Prevention Device Practice Installation Day. This is a voluntary educational emergency preparedness training event encouraged by FEMA. Business owners and employees are requested to practice the installation of the flood prevention devices. Therefore on Monday, October 24, 2016, we ask that you schedule a time to review your Floodproofing Measures Plan with all staff. This should include notification of where the flood prevention devices are stored and installation directions. All employees should be provided a copy of the Floodproofing Measures Plan and have the opportunity to install a flood prevention device at a designated opening.

In the event of a disaster, all property and business owners who have registered through the AlertOC system will receive an emergency alert notification. To register, go to www.alertoc.org.
