**Art and Nature Event at Main Beach** - On Wednesday, November 2, the Laguna Art Museum began installation of the temporary sculpture "1/4 Mile Arc" at Main Beach. The installation of 200 mirrored stainless steel poles will take two days to complete and will be on exhibition Friday, Saturday and Sunday, with removal on Monday, November 7, 2016.
