**Laguna SOCWA Wet Well Rehabilitation Project** - Beginning Thursday, April 6, 2017, the Water Quality Department will begin the nearly three month bypass phase of the Rehab project. The bypass system will go through operational testing for five consecutive days before the Laguna SOCWA Lift Station is taken out of service during its rehabilitation. **South Coast Water District's Coast Highway Recycled Water Bottleneck Project** - Pipeline construction will be starting on Tuesday, April 11, at 10 p.m. The following details are of note to the City's residents: 1) Construction will be from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday (i.e., preferred option by the community); 2) there will be two construction crews; 3) the project duration is approximately 6 weeks, 4) the project limits are from Aliso Way to 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue; 5) the Northbound Number 1 lane (i.e., far left lane, northbound) will be closed during the hours of 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.; 6) "No Parking" signs will be placed along the inland side of PCH (between Aliso and 10<sup>th</sup>) with a minimum of 48-hours' notice; 7) California Highway Patrol cruisers will be present during construction; and 8) project updates are available on their website: [scwd.org/pch](http://scwd.org/pch). and even more frequently at <https://www.facebook.com/SouthLagunaTunnelProject/>.
