Oak Street Beach Access - A ribbon cutting ceremony for the Oak Street Beach Access Improvement Project will be held at the project site on Tuesday, June 13, 2017, at 4:00 p.m. The project consisted of replacing the stairway, overlook decking, landscaping, lighting, benches and bike racks, and adding a new drinking fountain and foot wash.

Public Art Dedication - The public is invited to the dedication of “Tide Pool Kraken” and “Strand of Life” by Laguna Beach artist Casey Parlette on Monday, June 19, 2017, at 5:30 p.m. located at northern section of Heisler Park, overlooking Divers Cove. The bronze sculpture and stone and bronze bench have been donated by the Ostensen and Olenicoff Families.

Sunset Serenades: World Music - Sunset Serenades World Music Series concludes this Friday, June 9, 2017, with a performance by Marcela’s Noche de Flamenco. The concert is free and starts at 6:30 p.m. at the Heisler Park amphitheater on Cliff Drive. This program is funded by the lodging establishments and City of Laguna Beach.

Mountain Road Artist Designed Bench Proposals - On Monday, June 12, 2017, the Arts Commission will consider the artist proposals for Mountain Road. Caltrans – Rubberized Tree Well Installation - From June 16 through 21, Caltrans is scheduled to install rubberized tree wells in the sidewalks on Coast Highway from Mountain Road to Ledroit Street around the trees that were part of the sidewalk repair project last month. Work will be conducted between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. Closures will include one lane of traffic in each direction and sidewalks depending on the direction of the travel.
