SCE Pole Replacement by Helicopter - On Thursday, February 14, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Southern California Edison (SCE) will be replacing a pole located in the Aliso and Wood Canyons Wilderness Park. The pole is located approximately 2,500 feet southeast of Moulton Meadows Park. A helicopter will be used in the morning hours to remove and replace the pole. The landing zone and staging area for the helicopter will occur within the wilderness park approximately 2,100 feet north of Moulton Meadows Park and adjacent to the emergency fire access road.
