Holiday Street Sweeping Schedule - On Thursday, July 4, only non-residential areas will be swept. Residential street sweeping will not occur, and parking restrictions will not be enforced.

July 4 Laguna Beach Transit Hours - On Thursday, July 4, the trolleys will be operating special service hours. The Coastal routes will run from 9:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and the Canyon route will run from 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. There will be no transit service in the North and South Laguna neighborhoods, Top of the World, Bluebird Canyon or Arch Beach Heights neighborhoods. Laguna Beach Parking App - Laguna Beach residents, visitors, and business owners will be able to find available parking in real time using the new “Laguna Beach Parking” mobile smartphone App. With the Laguna Beach Parking app, users enter their destination in Laguna Beach to find the closest available parking in *real time*. Users can also pay for parking through the App, keep track of remaining time, and even extend their parking session remotely. The App will reduce circling, gridlock and traffic congestion in the Downtown area while showing drivers all available parking in *real time*. - **1369 Bluebird Canyon Drive** - On Wednesday, July 10, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., SCE will be replacing a utility pole located at 1369 Bluebird Canyon Drive. A portion of Bluebird Canyon Drive will be closed between Keller Way and Wykoff Way. A message board and detour signs will be posted to route traffic to adjacent streets during the work.
- **1850 Glenneyre Street** - On Thursday, July 11, between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., SCE will be replacing a utility pole located at 1850 Glenneyre Street. Traffic lanes at Glenneyre Street will be maintained, but shifted, in the vicinity of the work between Pearl Street and Center Street.
