SUBJECT: WEEKLY UPDATES

Moulton Meadows Park Playground Resurfacing - On September 16, work will begin to replace the playground safety surfacing at Moulton Meadows Park. SCE Pole Replacements - Southern California Edison (SCE) will be working in several areas of town next week. For questions or concerns, please contact SCE's Customer Service number at (800) 655-4555.

- **2030 Glenneyre Street** - On Tuesday, September 10, between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., SCE will be replacing a utility pole located at 2030 Glenneyre Street. Glenneyre Street, between Ruby Street and Diamond Street, will be closed during the work. Detour signs will be posted alerting residents of the temporary road closure.
- **361 Center Street** - On Thursday, September 12, between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., SCE will be replacing a utility pole located at 361 Center Street. Center Street, between Glenneyre Street and Catalina Street, will be closed during the work. Detour signs will be posted alerting residents of the temporary road closure.
- **910 Skyline Drive** - On Friday, September 13, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., SCE will be replacing a utility pole located at 910 Skyline Drive. Portions of Skyline Drive near Park Avenue may be blocked during the work and personnel will be directing traffic. Vehicular access to Skyline Terrace from Skyline Drive will be restricted during the work.

Help Keep Your Sewer Lateral Clean - A private sewer lateral is the pipe that drains your sinks, bathtubs, toilets and showers from your home or building to City's sewer main line. Proper maintenance of a private sewer lateral is important because they can clog with roots and grease and can cause a backup inside your property or spill from the line. Property owners are responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of their property's sewer lateral from the home including the point of connection with the City's sewer main line. It is recommended that all homeowners have their sewer laterals video-inspected on a periodic basis to ensure it is functioning properly. Contact a plumbing company participating in the City's program for a video inspection and lateral assessment. No matter the company you choose, be sure your plumber contacts the City's Plumber's Hotline before they begin work at (949) 464-6616. Be sure to request a copy of the lateral video inspection!

Getting Married in Laguna Beach? If you'd like to be married on public property in Laguna Beach, you'll need a wedding permit. Wedding permits are issued for most beaches and parks within the City's jurisdiction with some restrictions. We schedule ceremonies on a master calendar on a first-come, first-served basis upon receipt of the application and non-refundable use fee. Changes to your permit, such as date or time, must be in writing and a processing fee of \$10 is required. Additionally, the kit will contain emergency plan templates and disaster-specific information. Each red backpack will feature an official City of Laguna Beach Seal. Wildland Fire Engine and Neighborhood Outreach Event - The Laguna Beach Fire Department invites the community to attend a christening of the new wildland fire engine along with a neighborhood wildfire evacuation and outreach event on Saturday, September 7 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at Fire Station 2, located at 285 Agate Street in Laguna Beach. The City's newly released neighborhood-specific evacuation maps will be shared with the community to kick off our evacuation outreach campaign. This campaign is detailed in the Wildfire Mitigation and Fire Safety Report which was approved by the City Council in July. Disaster preparedness material will be handed out and the City's Emergency Kit Backpacks will also be available for purchase. Coffee, pastries, and donuts will be provided.
