SUBJECT: FRIDAY UPDATES

Laguna Relief and Resource Coalition – On Wednesday night, the Planning Commission approved a conditional use permit for the Coalition to use the building at 20652 Laguna Canyon Road which it is leasing from the City.

Farmer's Market – The Commission also approved space for six local vendors in a new area called “Laguna Lane.” This is intended to deal with questions raised by the Council about encouraging local businesses to participate in the Farmer's Market.

Sands Café – This restaurant at Aliso Beach will be applying for two changes to its Coastal Development Permit. The first change would allow the retention of two storage containers at the base of the bluff. The second would allow tables and chairs during operating hours on the sandy beach adjacent to the concession building.

North Laguna Alley Paving - The North Laguna Alley Rehabilitation Project is 95% completed. There have been some pavement quality problems in some areas because of the irregular and confined working space in some areas. Staff is negotiating with the contractor to slurry seal the entire project to provide a uniform pavement finish. The project will be completed on schedule by the end of the month.
