Workshop Regarding Disasters - On April 9, 2011, the City Council will host a community workshop in the Council Chambers to seek resident and business input regarding disasters. The workshop will be from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. with a one hour break for lunch (everyone is on their own for lunch). Jan Perkins, a Laguna Canyon resident and retired City Manager, will facilitate the workshop.

SBA Workshop - On Saturday, February 12, at 10 a.m., a workshop will be held in the Council Chambers where officials from the Small Business Administration will make a presentation on how victims of the floods can seek assistance.

New SBA Declaration - A new declaration has been made that may provide limited assistance to private non-profit organizations that provide essential services of governmental nature. (See Attachment)

Recruitment for Rookie and Seasonal Ocean Lifeguard. - The Department of Marine Safety is inviting applications for Rookie and Seasonal Ocean Lifeguard tryouts. Physical testing is on February 26 at 9 a.m. at Main Beach (sign in at 8 a.m.). Applications are due to the Personnel Division at City Hall by February 25 at noon.

Fund Raiser for Animal Shelter - It has come to my attention that a fund raiser is being put on to help the Animal Shelter! It will be on Sunday, March 13, 2011, at Tivoli Too! The fund raiser is being put on by Tivoli Too and the Laguna Board of Realtors and will consist of a champagne tasting and jazz brunch. Music will be provided by the George Gilliam Trio with guest singer Elena Gilliam. The cost is \$75 per person with \$25 of this going directly to the Laguna Beach Animal Shelter. Police Captain Mike Hall Retiring - After 31 years with the City, Captain Mike Hall will be retiring from the Police Department. For the past 4 years he has honorably served as the Commander of Patrol. Lieutenant Darin Lenyi will be taking over this important position in the Police Department.

Upcoming Caltrans Project - Caltrans will begin a project in mid-March on portions of North Coast Highway and Broadway/Laguna Canyon Road. The project will involve repair of sidewalk and concrete curbs. The areas of work will be North Coast Highway from Broadway to Cajon and on Laguna Canyon Road from Coast Highway to Canyon Acres. The work will be completed before the end of May.
