SUBJECT: WEEKLY UPDATES

Heisler Park Ribbon cutting – Various portions of Heisler Park have been closed for renovation since the fall. On Friday (June 17) at 4:00 p.m., the closed portions of the park will be reopened during a ribbon cutting ceremony north of the Rockpile Beach restroom near the breaching whale.

Fire Department Applicants - The Fire Department's Firefighter and Firefighter with Paramedic Certification job posting closed Friday, June 10th at 5:00 pm. Over 1,100 applications for Firefighter and approximately 250 applications for Firefighter with Paramedic Certification were received by the City.

Electric Car Charging Stations - Come join the Laguna Beach City Council in commissioning the City's first electric car charging stations into operation. On June 21, 2011, at 4:00 p.m., bring your electric car to the Laguna Canyon parking lot at the corner of Forest Avenue and Broadway in downtown Laguna Beach. The charging stations are part of the ChargePoint America (www.chargepointamerica.com) network. The equipment is provided through a grant from the United States Department of Energy.

Citywide Sidewalk Repairs – A \$90,000 project to replace damaged sidewalk at various locations citywide began this week. Much of the work will be within two neighborhoods, including Top of the World and the area generally bounded by Legion Street, Wilson Street, Brooks Street and South Coast Highway. The work will be done by the end of July. Work in the areas near Coast Highway will be done first.
