Artist Designed Bench Dedication - On Saturday, March 9, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. Mayor Boyd will dedicate the latest public art installation at Heisler Park. Titled, "Tidepool Paddleboard" the bench was created by Laguna Beach artist team Larry Gill and Gavin Heath. The bench is made of stainless steel and cast glass. This installation was funded through a donation by Beverly Kaye.

Boys and Girls City Track Meet - The City's annual Boys & Girls Track Meet will take place Friday, March 22 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Laguna Beach High School track and field. All children born in or after 1998 and reside or attend school within the Laguna Beach Unified School District are invited to attend. Participants may enter a maximum of three (3) events plus relays. The top finishers in each age division and event are eligible to compete at the County Track Meet in May. The **Heritage Committee** serves in an advisory role on matters pertaining to historic preservation such as placement of a structure which is not on the Historic Resources List on the Historic Register; removal of a structure from the Historic Register; creation of a special designation plaque program; alterations to "E" rated structures; and demolition of historic structures in a commercial zone.
