2013 Juried Fine Art Exhibition - The Arts Commission is currently accepting submissions to the sixth annual Juried Fine Art Exhibition. Applications are being accepted from Orange County artists 18 years of age or older. An application fee of \$25 is charged for up to three submissions. Art works must be two dimensional and measure no more than 36" by 36" framed. Selected art works will go on display at City Hall from October 15 through November 29, 2013. The first place winner will be awarded \$1,000. Deadline for submissions is September 9, 2013. All applications must be made at www.lagunabeachcity.slideroom.com. This program is funded by the lodging establishments and City of Laguna Beach.
