- 2. Approval of Minutes** – Approve the minutes of the July 24, 2014 regular meetings.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Old Business items, unless noted otherwise, have been reviewed by the Committee at one or more recent, prior meetings and have been noticed to affected persons by mail, publication, or other appropriate means.

- 3. Speed Limits Near Local Schools** – The PTC Committee will consider a request from the City Council to investigate and submit recommendations to the City Council by October 21 regarding options for reducing speed limits in the vicinities of Thurston Middle School and Laguna Beach High School.
- 4. Parking on La Mirada Street** –The PTC Committee will consider two proposals from residents on the 1300 block of La Mirada Street. The first proposal is to widen the roadway pavement within the existing City right of way in front of 1315 La Mirada Street to better accommodate parking. The second proposal is to restrict parking in front of 1315 La Mirada Street to improve driveway access for the property owners at 1320 La Mirada Street.
- 5. Traffic Controls on El Camino Del Mar and Short Street** – The PTC Committee will review the installation of the traffic controls approved by the City Council and installed at the intersection of El Camino Del Mar and Short Street to improve pedestrian safety and discuss additional traffic calming measures in the area.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

New Business items, unless noted otherwise, are being considered for the first time within the past two years and have not been noticed other than by posting of this agenda and notification to the requestor. Since most requests to the Parking, Traffic, and Circulation Committee are to change the status quo, the Committee may take any of the following actions at this meeting: (1) deny the request at this first hearing; (2) request further information and continue the item to another meeting as a New Business item; (3) direct the mailed noticing of the item and move the item to an Old Business item for a later meeting; (4) take any other action that the Committee deems appropriate based upon the information and testimony presented.

- 6. Parking Restriction on McAulay Place** – The PTC Committee will consider a request to restrict parking in front of 181 McAulay Place.

8. **Parking Restriction on Catalina and Palmer Place** – The PTC Committee will consider a request to restrict parking at the corner of Catalina and Palmer Place to allow emergency vehicles better access to Palmer Place.
9. **Parking Restriction in Alley Next to High Drive** – The PTC Committee will consider a request to allow parking in the alley next to 124 High Drive where it is currently restricted.
10. **Appoint Representative to the Laguna Canyon Road Task Force** – The PTC Committee will consider a request from the City Council to appoint a representative to the Laguna Canyon Road Task Force.
