



## **Best Practices for Voluntary Beach Clean-Up – COVID-19** *(Information provided by the Center for Disease Control)*

- Social Distance — volunteers should stay at least 6 feet away from people they do not live with.
- Avoid occupancy of small spaces.
- Encourage use of masks among beach clean-up volunteers. Masks should be worn when feasible and are **most** essential at times when social distancing is difficult.
- Masks should not be placed on
  - Children younger than 2 years old or
  - Anyone who has trouble breathing or is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the cover without assistance.
- Encourage handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available,
  - Adults and older children who can safely use hand sanitizer should use one that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Encourage beach clean-up volunteers to cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue or use the inside of their elbow, throw used tissues in the trash, and wash their hands immediately with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol, if soap and water are not readily available.
