Title: Public Art Maintenance Annual Report

Overview

At the direction of the Arts Commission, this year the Cultural Arts Department of the City of Laguna Beach began a formalized annual Public Art Maintenance program. The intent of this program is to assure the cultural Public Art legacy of the City and the Artists, and to protect the investment of these significant and unique Public Art Pieces placed throughout the community now and for future generations.

Summary of the Matter

The Cultural Arts Department has engaged independent contractor, Gerard Stripling, to facilitate the annual review and maintenance program. Over the course of each year all public art pieces are being reviewed for their overall condition, are being cleaned, and as required, are being refurbished.

Mr. Stripling has established a monthly calendar to ensure that each piece of public art is reviewed. The annual calendar is approved by the Cultural Arts Manager and implementation is overseen by the Public Arts Coordinator.

Over two dozen pieces were attended to over the last two quarters of this year (list attached). Each piece was cleaned as appropriate, which might include washing, vacuuming, waxing, metal polishing, calcium deposits removal, weed removal and/or vegetation trimming if infringing on the structures, and so on. Where there are special needs recognized for a particular piece, they are reported to staff who notes the concerns for future action or requests assistance from the appropriate city agencies to address.

When actual restoration is required on an art piece, staff first approaches the original artist to repair or refurbish at their expense. If that is not possible, or is declined by the artist, staff requests a meeting with the artist and Mr. Stripling to hear any advice on approaching the restoration, and Mr. Stripling moves forward with the work required.

On occasion there is the need to address unscheduled maintenance such as the removal of graffiti or repair of a piece that has suffered damage. There are also occasional cleaning and maintenance for special events scheduled by the City, such as the 9/11 Memorial Service.

This update on the maintenance of the City's collection of public art is informational and requires no action on the part of the Arts Commission.
