1) Donna Ballard called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

- 2) The minutes of the July 22, 2024 Regular Meeting were approved as presented. M/S Smith/Schwerner.
- 3) Chairs Announcements: Donna Ballard noted the concluding weekends of the Art Festivals and Pageant of the Masters.
- 4) Commissioner and Staff Communications: Pat Kollenda noted the performance of "The Mikado" by the Pacific Opera Company a collaborative event between the City of Laguna Beach and Festival of Arts. Austin Barrow thanked all the volunteers who assist with making the Arts a success in Laguna Beach. Staff Wood thanked Commissioners for attending the public art activation of "An Attempted Murder" by Jack Champion outside City Hall with an event facilitated by the Orange County Bird of Prey Center. Staff McGregor noted the upcoming deadline for the annual "Juried Fine Art Exhibition. Staff Poeschl noted the approval of an Artist Occupancy Permit for Bernhard Alvine, the Council approval of the Art in Public Places project for 1555 South Coast Highway and the Laguna Art Museum "Art and Nature". Staff Poeschl noted a grant application had been submitted to the National Endowment for the Arts "Our Town" opportunity for funding the art relating planning for the permanent Promenade on Forest.
- 5) **Public Communications:** Joy Dittberner, Executive Director of the Laguna Dance Festival thanked the Commission for its generous support and funding of its grant request through Cultural Arts Funding. Ms. Dittberner invited Commissioners to attend its event on September 26, 2024 at the Forum Theatre at the Festival of Arts grounds.
- A. Cleo Street Art in Public Places Following a presentation and discussion a motion was made to 1) approve the proposed scope of work and timeline for the project; 2) approve inviting artist Mike Tauber to submit a proposal for a public art mural for the Cleao Street Beach Access Improvement project with a stipend of \$1,500 for the design; and 3) increase the available budget for the Art in Public Places of \$14,000 by \$11,000 to \$25,000 allocated from the Art in Lieu Fund. M/S Schwerner/Smith. Yes: Ballard, Barrow, Chavel, Kollenda, Ray, Schwerner, Smith. Noes: None.

- B. <u>Public Art at the Glenneyre Parking Structure</u> Following a presentation and discussion a motion was made to direct the Public Art Sub-Committee to 1) determine the process of the procurement of public art, projected budget and scope of work; 2) to recommend augmenting the available Art in Public Places amount of \$14,000 from the Art in Lieu Fund to be determined by the sub-committee; and 3) return to the Commission with a recommendation. M/S Kollenda/Schwerner. Yes: Ballard, Barrow, Chavel, Kollenda, Ray, Schwerner, Smith. Noes: None.
- C. Promenade on Forest Temporary Installation A motion was made to 1) Allocate \$5,000 from the Arts Commission Special Programs Budget to fund temporary art installations on Forest Avenue; 2) Approve the installation of "Protect Don't Pollute" by Amy Rose Hammond from September 2, 2024 to December 2, 2024, at a cost of \$5,000; 3) Approve the installation of "Marine Harmony" by Sara Dehghan from March 3, 2025 to June 2, 2025, at a cost of \$5,000. ## Overview

The City of Laguna Beach Arts Commission presents 245 live performance events annually, including Sunset Serenades, World Music Series, Stage at the Promenade on Forest and Music in the Park.

## Summary of the Matter

In the current year 2024/25 budget the Arts Commission has allocated \$131,500 for the presentation of Music in the Park, Sunset Serenades, World Music concerts, weekly performances at the Promenade on Forest, Pacific Opera Project at the Festival of Arts, "On the Go" concert by the Pacif Symphony and an annual performance by Circus Bella.

Dates for Music in the Park, Sunset Serenades and World Music reflect the same number of concerts and similar dates as presented in 2024. The Music in the Park concerts were brought forward a week to reflect the Laguna Beach Unified School District schedule. (June 12, 2025 - LBUSD last day of school - August 21, 2025 - LBUSD first day of school.) Circus Bella has confirmed their performance to be held on the first Saturday in June prior to the close of the school season.

It is recommended the Commission approve the following events and dates. Staff will continue to work with the Performance sub-committee in exploring additional live performance experiences for the community.

#### Overview

The City of Laguna Beach Cultural Arts Department utilizes the first-floor hallways of City Hall as a year-round exhibition space for local arts organizations and City-sponsored competitions. City Hall has been host to exhibitions by Laguna College of Art & Design, The Artist Fund at the Festival of Arts, Community Art Project, Laguna Plein Air Painters Association, and the Festival of Arts Permanent Collection in addition to the City's annual Juried Fine Art, Art That's Small and Children's Holiday Palette competitions. These exhibitions serve to enhance the interior space of City Hall with high-quality art from local artists and arts organizations as well as engage members of the community to show support for the arts by local government.

## Summary of the Matter

The exhibition schedule has been updated for 2025 and reflects the dates and organizations for exhibition. City staff coordinates with organizations to install and remove exhibitions during hours that City Hall is closed to the public. Exact dates may be subject to change based on the availability of the organizations' staff.

## Recommendation:
