Street Performing FAQs

FOREST AVENUE PROMENADE

Wooden Stage in the heart of the Downtown
(permit and booking required)

How to apply:

Performance application is available at lagunabeachcity.net
Requires proof of identity. Description of performance can include video, social media link, photographs, etc.

- Application will be reviewed and if approved, you will be offered an available timeslot scheduled through the Cultural Arts Department
- The Cultural Arts Department reserves the right to cancel, revoke or suspend the permit at any time.
- Performances at the Promenade on Forest may only occur on the designated stage.
- Maximum performance time of **three (3) hours**.
- You may ask for donations by having a hat or open case.

CITY-WIDE

(Please note - Street performances are not allowed at the Forest Avenue Promenade, the Heisler Park Amphitheater or the corners of Coast Hwy/Forest Ave or Glenneyre St/Forest Ave.)

- No application required
- No permit required
- No business license required
- You may perform **between the hours of 11 a.m. and 9 p.m.**

You may perform at any street with adherence to the following:

- Must be at least 10' away from bus stops, street corners, business entrances and crosswalks.
- Do not block the sidewalk with performance or equipment.
- You may ask for donations, but you cannot charge a fee.
- You must perform within two hours of setting up equipment and must stay with your items at all times.
- No power generators allowed.



Please comply with appropriate decibel levels, and if asked to reduce volume, do so immediately.

Performers under 16 years old require an entertainment work permit issued by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California.
